Thank you for your support of the Hancock Health Foundation in 2017. We are fortunate to have individuals like you faithfully supporting our mission. Thanks to you and other generous donors, we were able to accomplish great things over the past year.

- Through donations to Women Helping Women, we have provided screening mammograms, 3D mammograms, breast biopsies and MRIs, clinical exams and prosthesis for hundreds of women. Due to a lack of insurance or limited resources, these women would otherwise be unable to receive these life-saving health care services.
- Hancock Health has provided end-of-life care to hundreds of patients through our hospice program, some in the hospital's peaceful Transitions Unit and others in the comfort of their own home. Donations to the Rex A. Pasko Hospice Endowment help us to continue providing care and support to hospice patients and their families for years to come.
- The Sue Ann Wortman Cancer Center opened in 2015 and has treated roughly 2,300 patients to date through medical oncology, hematology and radiation. Besides being home to some of the area's top cancer specialists, our cancer center offers massage therapy, nutritional and financial counseling, support groups and clinical trials for its patients. Your gifts make it possible for people in our community to receive comprehensive cancer care close to home.
- Scholarships were awarded to 16 students in 2017, totaling \$50,000, to support their education in medical fields. Donations to our golf benefit made these scholarships possible.
- The renovation of the Andis Women's & Children's Department is well underway and is expected to be completed this spring. Our community joined together to raise over \$250,000 in support of this important project.


