Describe the project need or event:

With food, landmarks and statues being the most photographed and shared on social media, it is WCMP's intention to do something special here in Hancock County, which would promote, increase tourism and bring awareness to Hancock County's own, Col. H. Weir Cook.

WCMP would like to depict a public art sculpture of Col. Cook's Spad XIII airplane. The airplane we're wanting to display is not just an ordinary airplane of war. Col. Cook flew with the famed war heroes of WWI "The 94th Aero Squadron, Hat In The Ring" and his group was picked to paint a scheme on their aircraft and to be flown over Paris at wars end. This hand picked group was nicknamed the "Showbirds". Once painting was complete the other pilots and crew would get their picture taken by the planes. It has been said Col. Cooks Spad XIII was the most photographed aircraft.

We believe by recreating Col. Cook's airplane as a public sculpture and placing it in the Weir Cook Community Park we could attract more tourist to Hancock County and local businesses as well. Not to mention, in the future the Weir Cook Community Park will be utilized in the trail system, which will connect us all.

How will the funding of this request increase tourism or impact other Hancock County businesses in a positive manner?

This project will draw attention to the eastern side of Hancock county by bringing a functional art sculpture for public display at the Weir Cook Community Park in Wilkinson, IN. A one of a kind piece of art that not only educates but will allow people to be photographed with Col. Cook, WWI and II, Indiana's ace. This metal art sculpture will increase tourism by people taking photos and placing them on the internet, which can draw thousands of others to see and share. This one time project will last for generations to come. It's been our experience over the last 18 years that organic advertising has been successful in increasing tourism and awareness. For example, after WCMP restored the Weir Cook Community Park, named the terminal along with building the bronze statue that is presently at the Indianapolis International Airport. More people than ever are recognizing the Weir Cook Memorial Project for their contributions to our military veterans and Indiana's military history.
